WHY: After years of planning, CCSPCA is opening the doors to its new low-cost spay/neuter clinic. The state-of-the-art facility is the answer to the question many in the Central Valley ask: *where can owners get low-cost medical and spay/neuter services?* The answer is now CCSPCA!

In the coming weeks the clinic will offer the following services—appointments available soon!

- Low-cost spay/neuters
- Low-cost vaccinations
- Wellness/preventative care
- Routine dental procedures
- Microchipping
- Lab services
- X-rays
- Nail trims

Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Vouchers Will Be Available June 27, 2022

CCSPCA's commitment to helping curb Central Valley's overwhelming animal overpopulation problem is nothing new. The organization has continually applied for and received grants in order to offer free and low-cost spay/neuters to pet owners in the community.

To kick off the grand opening celebration, CCSPCA will be offering vouchers for **100 cat/dog spays/neuters** on **Monday, June 27**, from **7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** **Please do not bring your pet.**

- Vouchers are \$15/cat and \$25/dog and are non-refundable.
- Dogs and cats must be between 4 months and 5 years old.
- Surgeries will be scheduled beginning on Tuesday, June 28.
- Rabies vaccination is required for both dogs and cats. Present a valid current certificate or add a vaccine (\$10 for dogs and \$15 for cats) at your appointment.

Funding for these services is possible thanks to \$48,000 worth of grants awarded by the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA). Additional vouchers will be available in the future.

Fixin' Fresno - No Nuts Left Behind Spay/Neuter Program

- \$40,500 is for 600 routine spays/neuters (300 cats & 300 dogs) in the top 12 zip codes in the Fresno area with the highest number of strays
 - Eligible Zip Codes: 93702, 93706, 93722, 93726, 93727,
- 93705, 93728, 93701, 93710, 93703, 93720, and 93721
- There is a 4 dog per household limit.
- Proof of address with picture ID.

Paws & Claws Spay/Neuter Program

- \$7,500 is for 111 routine spays/neuters for 56 dogs and 55 cats.
- No zip code or other location restrictions.
- Cats and dogs MUST be owned pets - no feral/free-roaming community cats.
- Two vouchers per household limit.

More about Fixin' Fresno: CDFA's Pet Lover's License Plate Grant Program

CCSPCA was presented with a \$40,500 grant in June 2022. CDFA awarded \$477,780 in grants to 11 animal welfare organizations working to reduce animal overpopulation via spay/neuter programs. CCSPCA thanks CDFA for their continued support.
