### **Can't Eat**

- Turkey Skin
- Turkey Bones
- Gravy Stuffing
- Raisins/Grapes
- Onion
- Nuts
- Mushrooms
- Butter
- Bread Dough/Baked Goods

- Alcohol
- Sage
- Chocolate

### **Can Eat**

- Turkey (Light Meat Only)
- Mashed Potatoes (No Butter)
- Pumpkin
- Apples
- Green Beans (Plain)
- Dog Treats

### **Please Keep In Mind**

- If you expect guests at your home, put your pet in another room so they don't try to escape via an open door.
- Make sure your cats and dogs have identification tags with updated information.
- Take a current photo of all of your cats and dogs.
- If your pet does go missing, please contact your local animal shelter.
